Physicians and patients often have no alternative other than to follow the formulary restrictions because they lack the means to purchase medications or insurance on their own.

Background:

Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) control costs using a variety of methods including utilization management and formulary restrictions. Formulary restrictions have been shown to reduce prescription costs, but may lead to increased cost in other areas and result in medication nonadherence.^{1,2} Eliminating formulary restrictions to life saving medications has been shown along with disease management to improve patient outcome and ultimately control healthcare costs.^{3,4} Recently some insurers and payers have indicated an interest in reducing copays to medications that have proven to be associated with positive clinical and economic consequences in order to promote patient adherence, and ultimately improve outcomes. Not all payers and insurers have embraced this trend and formulary restrictions remain a key intervention in managing an insurers cost.

Methods:

GRAAHI will review the formulary management practices of Michigan MCOs, relevant to access to medications for disease states of high prevalence in African Americans.

Inclusion Criteria:

Disease states to be reviewed include cardiovascular (hypertension and hyperlipidemia), asthma, diabetes, and mental health.

Medication classes to treat these diseases will be evaluated if a representative product is included in the top 100 most widely prescribed drugs listed by IMS in the 2006 report of the Top 200 dispensed medications in the United States.⁶ IMS is the leading provider of business intelligence and strategic consulting services for the pharmaceutical and healthcare industries.⁷

In order to fairly represent all medications within a drug class, other oral medications as listed by the American Hospital Formulary Service (AHFS) from the selected classes will be included in the evaluation.⁸ AHFS is a well-known classification system frequently utilized by hospital and managed care formulary decision makers. Since AHFS does not classify combination products, these agents will only be included in the evaluation if they contain an ingredient in the evaluated medication classes and appear in the IMS top 100 dispensed medications.

Based on these criteria the classes of medications to be evaluated for the respective disease states will include:

Cardiovascular (Beta Blockers, ACE-inhibitors, Platelet Aggregation Inhibitors, and Antilipemics)

Asthma (Corticosteroids, Selective Adrenergics, Leukotriene Modifiers)

Diabetes (Insulins, Sulfonylureas, Thiazolidinediones)

Mental Health (atypical Antipsychotics, Selective Serotonin Reuptake Inhibitors (SSRIs), Selective Serotonin and Norepinephrine Reuptake Inhibitors (SSNRIs))

Commercial and Medicaid MCOs will be included in the analysis if they have a publicly accessible formulary. Data will be obtained from Michigan MCOs between July 1 and August 15, 2007.

Medications will be determined to have good access if the medication is listed on the publicly accessible formulary as either Tier 1 or Tier 2 (low co-pay) without restriction. Restriction is defined as any barrier that either a doctor or patient must overcome in order to get the medication.

Examples of a restriction or barrier include:

Step Edit (SE): Medication requires a trial of another medication prior to the patient receiving the initial medication prescribed by the physician

Prior Authorization (PA): Medication is not available unless the doctor contacts the MCO and receives approval to prescribe the medication.

MCOs may implement medication management practices which optimize delivery of healthcare. These types of practices will be interpreted as acceptable formulary restrictions

Examples of good management which do not impair medication access:

Quantity Limit (QL): MCOs may place quantity limits on medications in order to prevent excessive medication use



Data will be extracted by GRAAHI staff as to the availability of medications. These data will be placed into an Excel spreadsheet for analysis. Plans will be ranked in order of the number and percent of medications with good access.

Assumptions:

Medications not listed on the published formulary are assumed to be either restricted or unavailable

Limitations:

This evaluation process is based completely on the availability of medications as listed on the formulary at each MCO. This rating only applies to the accessibility of medications and does not evaluate the MCO on provision of medical, dental, vision, or any covered services or responsiveness to patient service requests. The selection of a MCO is an individual decision and consideration of all points of service should occur by the patient before making a selection. In addition this evaluation of medication access is not intended to take the place of physician judgment in prescribing medications to patients. Regardless of availability, the decision to prescribe medication is one that should be made between the doctor and patient.

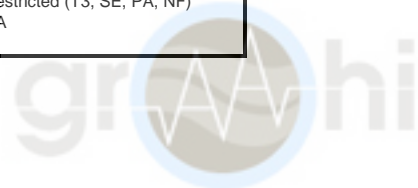
